18 Petitioner's *Ex Parte* Application for the Court to resolve Respondent, Jimmy Gulzar's  
19 visitation schedule with minor child, Phoenix Gulzar, age 8, born February 19, 1999, for the period  
20 December 28, 2007 through February 24, 2008, came on regularly for hearing on December 11, 2007,  
21 at 8:30 a.m., in Department 2, the Honorable Robert Schneider, presiding, as result of Department 65,  
22 with Honorable Amy Pellman, being dark that day. Notice was properly duly given by the Petitioner's  
23 counsel.

24 The Honorable Robert Schneider provided a tentative decision that the schedule was reasonable  
25 and the travel was wonderful for a minor child of this age. The Ex Parte was set on a shortened time  
26 for December 19, 2007.

27 On December 19, 2007, the Honorable Robert Schneider presided over this matter again as  
28 Respondent did not stipulate to Commissioner Amy Pellman in Department 65.

1 On December 19, 2007, Petitioner, Melanie J. Brown was not present but was represented by  
2 Goldie Schon, Esq., of Nachshin & Weston, LLP her attorney of record. Respondent, Jimmy B.  
3 Gulzar, in propria persona was present.

4 The Court, after considering the *Ex Parte* Application of Petitioner, and the documents  
5 submitted in connection therewith, and after hearing the oral presentations and argument of counsel,  
6 made the following Orders.

7 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

8 1. The relief requested by Petitioner to resolve the temporary modification of scheduling  
9 of Respondent, Jimmy Gulzar's visitation with the minor child for the period December 28, 2007  
10 through February 24, 2008 is granted.

11 2. Petitioner continues to maintain sole legal and sole physical custody of the minor child  
12 Phoenix Gulzar, age 8, born February 19, 1999, pursuant to the parties' October 22, 2003 Judgment  
13 in England, which High Court Orders have been registered in the State of California.

14 3. The custodial schedule for the minor child, Phoenix Gulzar, age 8, born February 19,  
15 1999, for the period December 28, 2007 through February 24, 2008 shall be as follows:

- 16 A. Respondent, Jimmy Gulzar shall have visitation with the minor child from
- 17 12:00 p.m., on December 28, 2007 through 12:00 p.m., January 11, 2008;
- 18 B. Petitioner, Melanie Brown shall have custody of the minor child from
- 19 12:00 p.m., on January 11, 2008 through 12:00 p.m., February 10, 2008;
- 20 C. Respondent, Jimmy Gulzar shall have visitation with minor child from
- 21 12:00 p.m., on February 11, 2008 through February 24, 2008;
- 22 D. For the year 2008 only, Respondent, Jimmy Gulzar shall have visitation with
- 23 minor child on her birthday, February 19, 2007 with no custodial time to
- 24 Petitioner on said day;
- 25 E. Petitioner, Melanie Brown shall have custody of the minor child from
- 26 12:00 p.m., on February 24, 2008 through 6:00 p.m., on March 7, 2008.

1 3. Respondent shall resume his permanent visitation schedule with Phoenix as stated in  
2 the Orders of the High Court entered October 22, 2003, and as specifically modified in the Order filed  
3 on March 19, 2004, as follows: Alternate weekends from Friday at 6:00 p.m., through Sunday at 6:00  
4 p.m. Respondent shall resume his permanent visitation schedule on March 7, 2008.

5 4. The exchange location shall remain [REDACTED] for all exchanges.

6 5. Petitioner shall provide Respondent with the currently known addresses of where the  
7 minor child will reside during Petitioner's physical custody period, indicated above. If any residential  
8 changes of the minor child occur after information is provided, Petitioner shall notify Respondent  
9 within forty-eight (48) hours of the change.

10 6. Petitioner shall once again provide Respondent with her cellular telephone number in  
11 order to communicate with the minor child.

12 7. Respondent shall take the minor child to school during the period that he has  
13 visitation, as indicated above.

14 8. Respondent shall be entitled to have two (2) telephone conversations with the minor  
15 child's tutor to obtain general information. Respondent shall not be entitled to any specific  
16 information and/or documentation, included, but not limited to, lesson plans, homework completed,  
17 or any other specific information and/or documentation.

18 A. Respondent shall cooperate with Petitioner's counsel, Goldie Schon in order  
19 to coordinate and effectuate the telephone communications with the tutor in England.

20 9. The parties shall complete the Court requirement of attending conciliation court by  
21 March 30, 2008.

22 10. All other relief requested by Respondent either in Responsive pleadings to  
23 Petitioner's Order to Show Cause or orally in Court on December 19, 2007 is denied.
